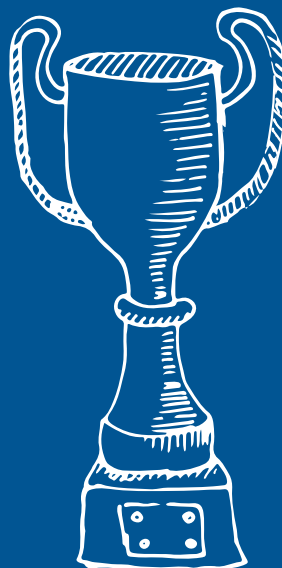
was the featured Homecoming game in fall 2015. SPA plans to rotate the featured game every Homecoming among the fall sports
